Who we are?

National Institute for Autism (NAUTIS) is an NGO providing people on the autism spectrum, their families and other stakeholders involved with complex support including psychological, therapeutic, social and educational services, or leisure-time activities.

What we do?

As a social service called Social Rehabilitation, we aim to support people on the autism spectrum in developing communication, self-care, work and other social skills in order to secure the desired level of self-reliant and independent life within the society.

For whom?

The Social Rehabilitation services are provided to people on the spectrum above the age of 15 living in the regions of Prague and Central Bohemia.

How much does it cost?

In accordance with the local law (108/2006Sb. on social services) the provided services are free of charge.
